

Seat Cover Cleaning Instructions



Seat covers may be machine washed, but not dried. Use lukewarm water and mild detergent. *Do not use liquid fabric softener or bleach.*

Step 1: Coil and bind the fastening straps with a rubber band.

Step 2: Wrap the coil in a plastic sandwich bag and secure again with a rubber band. This way the straps will not flail and harm the seat covers and catch onto seams in the tumbling process.

Step 3: Hang dry.

Seat covers may be cleaned, without removal, with a wet soapy cloth, we recommend Dawn soap. Spray-on upholstery cleaners can be used and vacuumed off. Dog hair can easily be wiped off with a wet cloth.

To keep your color looking new, we suggest purchasing a UV Protectant spray. We have used 303 Aerospace and you can find it on Amazon or at a local hardware or sporting goods store.
